





Distribution Insights

While current M&A activity remains high relative to historical levels, a confluence of factors impacting the distribution sector has led to a slight decline in transaction volume year-over-year. A continued focus on M&A growth, availability of financing and an uptick in corporate divestitures helped keep M&A activity strong in Q3 2019, while concerns regarding the impact of tariffs with the continued trade war and economic shifts had an impact on buyer sentiment during the quarter.


Despite the noise in the market, companies have continued to leverage M&A as a strategy to boost their geographic footprint and broaden their value-added service offerings, and private equity buyers have continued to pay premiums for scarce buyand-build distribution platforms. These trends are evidenced by several landmark transactions announced or closed this quarter, including the take-private of Wesco Aircraft Holdings by Pattonair, a portfolio company of Platinum Equity, in a transaction valued at \$1.9 billion. Littlejohn & Co. also completed its acquisition of Kaman Corporation's distribution segment in August, and Genuine Parts Company agreed to sell its subsidiary EIS Inc. and the Electrical Specialties Group of Motion Industries to Audax Private Equity. Looking ahead, Lincoln anticipates strong distribution M&A volume in the remainder of 2019, and we would welcome the opportunity to discuss your company's strategic alternatives or the distribution market more generally.


Index Performance


Lincoln's Distribution Index recorded a gain of 1.8% in Q3 2019 vs. Q2 2019. Consumer Products (+5.1%), Technology (+4.2%), Communications, Electronics & Electrical (+4.1%), Building Products (+3.7%) outpaced the index while Automotive and Truck (+0.9%), Industrial (+0.1%), Healthcare (-0.6%) and Aerospace and Defense (-0.8%) lagged the index.

9/24/2019: HD Supply Holdings (NasdaqGS:HDS), the Georgia-based industrial distributor, announced plans to separate its facilities maintenance (FM) and its construction and industrial (C&I) business into two separately traded entities.

8/14/2019: **Sysco (NYSE:SYY)**, the Texas-based distributor of food and related products, is watching for targets in and around its current service areas and will be opportunistic on sizeable deals.

9/4/2019: **GMS (NYSE:GMS)**, the Georgia-based specialty distributor of interior building products, will continue to seek acquisitions to grow its footprint under new CEO John Turner.

8/9/2019: Pattonair, a portfolio company of Platinum Equity, has entered a definitive merger agreement to acquire **Wesco** Aircraft Holdings Inc. (NYSE:WAIR), the California-based aerospace supply distributor and provider of supply chain management services for \$1.9 billion.
